Each film project and each 'Factory' activity will have a budget associated with it. Production/activity cost will be either shared equitably among participants of that project and/or paid for with sponsoring funds. Cost to members for such items as DVD's, Demo Reels, T-shirts, etc. (if desire) will be at a "Factory" nominal fee. Membership fees are strictly to help cover day-to-day operating expenses and special events and are not intended to fund specific film projects.

Use of 'Factory' filmmaking equipment, if available, is subject to availability and limited to responsible persons qualified in the use of that equipment. All consumables such as video tapes, DVD blanks, bulbs, etc. must be replaced. Persons checking out equipment must sign an Equipment Use Agreement that stipulates the repair or replacement of any items that are lost, stolen or damaged.

Certain film projects will require additional releases and agreements signed by the various participants as a requirement for public screenings, submittal to film festivals and distribution.
